VENUE

Roche Estate is located on the corner of Broke & McDonald Rds, Pokolbin, The venue is a magnificent grassed open-air venue. Patrons are encouraged to bring a camp chair to the event., picnic rugs are not permitted. All areas of this venue have view of the stage.

COVID 19

The event will be produced in accordance with the NSW Government Health Guidelines. Please check back to this website regularly for updates. TICKET TYPES

General Admission tickets are \$128.90 including booking and credit fees. Transaction fees may apply. Patrons with General Admission tickets will receive access to the main lawn area, where unreserved seating is available (BYO Camp Chair)

Rock Bar tickets are \$228.90 including booking and credit fees. Transaction fees may apply. The Rock Bar is located on the concourse towards the rear of the site. It has view of the stage. The area has unreserved tables, chairs, umbrellas and shade areas as well as a private bar and toilets. A BBQ dinner is also provided as part of this ticket. The Rock Bar is not a VIP Facility, it is a retreat for patrons to enjoy the day and you may come and go from this area at any time. All patrons entering this area must have a valid Rock Bar ticket, regardless of age.

TRANSPORT / PARKING

DISABLED PATRONS

Disabled parking is available in an unreserved area within close proximity to the event entry – please follow directions of parking staff for access. This area is unreserved and available for disabled patrons and their immediate carer only. The Red Hot Summer Tour accepts companion cards for an immediate carer attending the event with a disabled patron. Please present your accreditation at entry to gate staff. Patrons please note that this is an outdoor venue with some uneven surfaces and is open to the elements. If you require any assistance on the day please ask one of our staff or security.

BOX OFFICE / TICKETING

The Box Office is located at the concert entry point and will be open 60 minutes prior to gates opening until the headline artist commences. Please have your ticket printed and ready for scanning at the gates.

ROCK BAR TICKET HOLDERS

Patrons holding Rock Bar tickets please enter the venue through the general admission lane and proceed to the concourse stairs at the rear of the site. Here you will be given your accreditation. The area has unreserved tables, chairs, umbrellas and shade areas as well as a private bar and toilets. A BBQ dinner is also provided as part of this ticket. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is a condition of entry that all bags, chairs, eskies and personal belongings be presented to security staff for inspection and scanning at entry. FOOD & BEVERAGE

AGE RESTRICTIONS

This event is strictly 18+.

WEATHER POLICY

This event is an open air concert that will proceed rain, hail or shine. In the very unlikely event of an event cancellation, all ticketholders will be advised via SMS, Email, Social Media as well as an update on this website. The event will only be cancelled if the site is deemed too dangerous to proceed / continue. This decision will be made by Event Management / Security / The Venue and Emergency Services.
